Police and criminal activities from February 22 – 28, 2010

Mon. Feb. 22, 10:32 am: Subject(s) gained entry into a parked vehicle at 4471 N.W. 36th Street (Int'l City Building) by breaking out the front passenger side window. Subject(s) removed a purse, wallet, \$120.00 and miscellaneous documents. The estimated loss is \$502.

Mon. Feb. 22, 11:18 pm: Subject(s) gained entry into a residence in the 500 block of Minola Drive by forcing open a rear door. Once inside a computer was removed from a table in the living room and another computer was removed from a bedroom closet. The estimated loss is \$2,000.
